READ ISAIAH 55:1-3 • PRAY

Review:

- God speaks to people through his Word and his Spirit.
- He speaks to those who pursue him.
- We test our “promptings” against God’s Word with God’s people.

Simple Recipe for Hearing God

With Faith: **Read . Pray . Discuss . Obey**

Do not merely listen to the word, and so deceive yourselves. Do what it says.

James 1:22

[Jesus] “Therefore everyone who hears these words of mine and puts them into practice is like a wise man who built his house on the rock...”

Matthew 7:24

IF WE HEAR, WE MUST OBEY

Do not put out the Spirit’s fire; do not treat prophecies with contempt. Test everything. Hold on to the good. Avoid every kind of evil.

1 Thessalonians 5:19-22

SOME THINGS PREVENT, SOME THINGS DISTORT, BUT IT’S POSSIBLE TO QUENCH

*If we hear, we must obey, or God might **stop speaking**.*

I WANT YOU TO KNOW WHY GOD SPEAKS TO HIS PEOPLE

God speaks to **give life**.

FROM THE DAYS OF THE GARDEN OF EDEN, PEOPLE HAVE THOUGHT OF GOD’S WORD AS LIMITING...
EVEN EVE AND THE SERPENT •• IF WE SEE GOD’S WORD AS LIMITING, WE WILL RESIST!!

vv. 1-3 :: God satisfies us with delight.

vv. 3-5 :: God endows us with splendor.

vv. 6-9 :: God offers us himself.

vv. 10-11 :: God’s Word always works.

PROMISE:

Following God’s **voice** always
leads to God’s **results**.

WARNING:

If we won’t **obey** the word that’s **given**,
God has no reason to give **more**.

vv. 12-13 :: God offers joy and blessing.

God speaks to give life!

Those who hear and follow, live!

Have you been hearing? Have you been following?

DO YOU NEED THE PROMISE OR THE WARNING?

Come, all you who are thirsty, come to the waters; and you who have no money, come, buy and eat! Come, buy wine and milk without money and without cost.
